Send Mentors

Employees (engineers and anyone excited about tech) may volunteer to serve as mentors at the hackathon to help participants with creating their projects.

Rep in API Directory

Your company's API will be offered to participants to utilize in the building of their projects; this provides your API with a chance to familiarize with the next generation of engineers.

Your company can send recruiters to the hackathon to meet with participants and conduct interviews.

Your company will have a room reserved for your company to hold interviews with participants for recruiting.

Access to Participant Resumes

Your recruiters and talent searchers will have access to all participant resumes.
